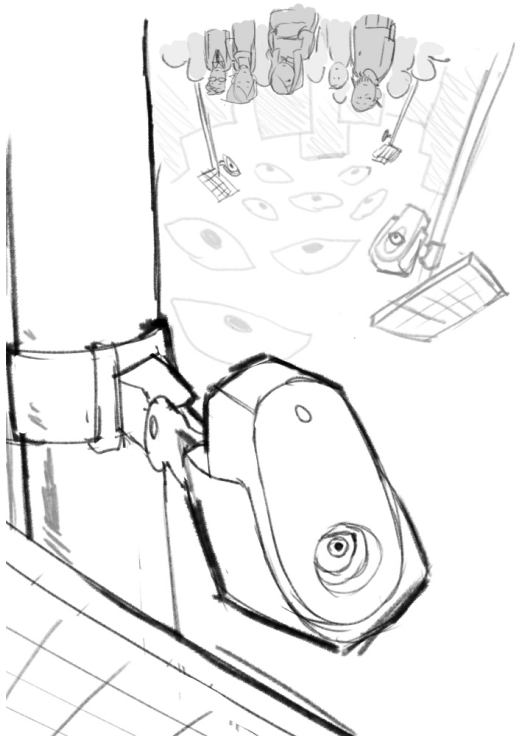

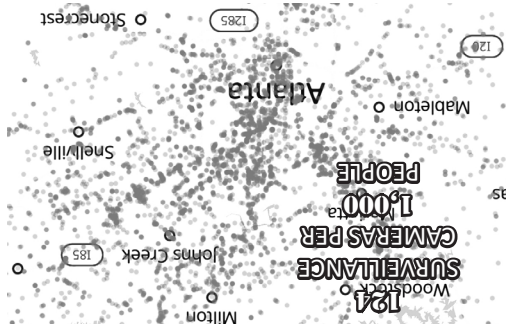

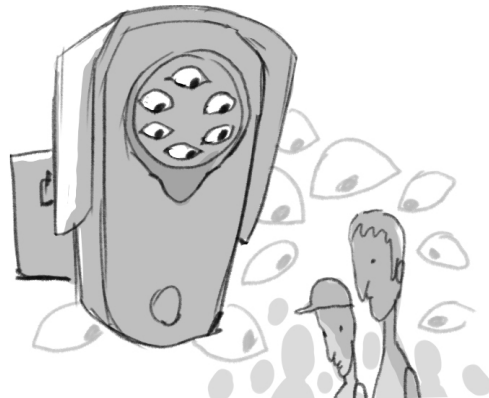
Don't Flock cameras reduce crime?

Data released by the FBI shows that the city's mass surveillance has had virtually **zero impact** on the Atlanta Police Department's ability to solve crime¹.

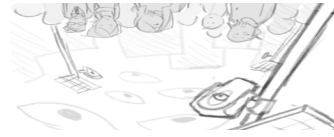

Not in Atlanta. Overall Crime Clearance Rates have Declined, NOT IMPROVED

Homicide Rates 53.4% to 48% in 2025. According to Atlanta Community Press Collective, FBI data shows homicide clearance rates in Atlanta have dropped.



Human Trafficking

APD reported 37 cases of human trafficking from October 2020-Mid 2026. Only 7 of those cases were cleared before May 2024. The 12 human trafficking incidents reported after 2024 have **ZERO CASES SOLVED**¹.

Flock Causes Safety Concerns

- In one California town, **Flock misread license plates in 71%** of the alerts it sent to police.

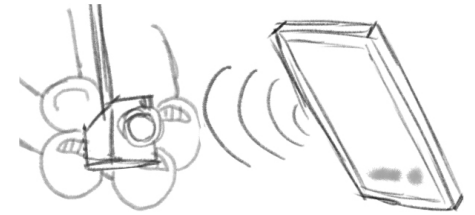
- Joel Feder from The Drive news outlet was surrounded by armed police officers in a parking lot in Minnesota. He spent hours explaining why he drives luxury vehicles for a living and is not a car thief. He had to prove his innocence to avoid arrest. **Flock system** captured unclear footage which missed two numbers of Joel's license plate, causing it to match the full plate of the stolen vehicle they were investigating.

Fortunately his influence kept him out of handcuffs!

Flock Data Falsely Accuses Florida Woman of Murder

Lindsey Isaacs was falsely accused of a hit and run based on Flock data.

Police accused her of a hit and run that killed three people. Florida patrol impounded her car without even looking for damage. Lindsey was facing **8 felony counts, life in prison, spent 13 days in jail, and had to come up with a \$250,000 bail.**

When investigated it was clear this was the wrong vehicle.

Flock misread the plate!
